# Required Documents

What documents do I need to apply for a U.S. Passport?

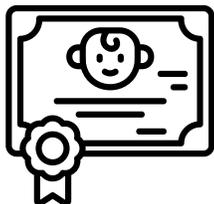
The purpose of this guide is to give you a **general** idea of the passport application process. The U.S. Department of State's information supersedes the information contained in this guide.



## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS LIST

Form [DS-11](#)

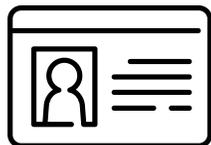
**Most students will use form DS-11. Please research and confirm what [form](#) you need to use prior to starting your passport application.**



- Form DS-11 is for all first time passport applicants and those who need to renew a passport that was issued **before age 16**.
- Form DS-11 has instructions about how to complete your application form for application sections that are not self-explanatory. Please read form DS-11 in its entirety and reference those instructions as you fill out the form.
- **Glue** your recent passport photo to your application, in the required field. **Please do not staple your passport photo to your application.**

### Proof of U.S. Citizenship (choose one)

- U.S. Birth Certificate
- Expired (or expiring) Passport

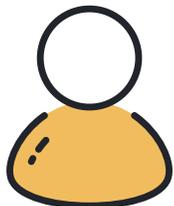


### Proof of Identity (choose one)

- Driver's License
- Previous or Current U.S. Passport Book
- Previous or Current U.S. Passport Card
- Military ID
- Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship

### Recent Color Photograph

- **DO NOT SUBMIT A PHOTO YOU TOOK OR PRINTED. IT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** This can result in significant delays.
- You **must** go to CVS, the post office, or another location where you pay to have your photo taken specifically for passports.



### Passport Fee

**ALL [FEES](#) MUST BE PAID BY MONEY ORDER OR CHECK. CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**

The cost of a U.S. passport is **\$130** plus a **\$35** "Execution (Acceptance) Fee"

### Additional Fees (Optional)

- **Expedited Service - \$60**
- **1-2 Day Delivery - \$19.53** (This means once your passport issued, you will receive it 1 to 2 days **after** the government sends it back to you via USPS)



**Arcadia Abroad recommends you pay for the expedited service AND 1-2 day delivery to ensure the quickest timeline.**

# Submitting Your Documents

## Where do I submit my documents?

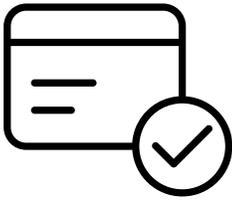
### I have all the required documents. Where do I submit them?

There are **two** options for you to submit your passport application, both of which require you **make an appointment**. Do this as soon as you possibly can.



#### Acceptance Facilities

- Use [this search engine](#) to find a local office to submit your application!
  - **Post Offices** – To schedule an appointment at your local USPS office, please use [this webpage](#).
  - **Clerks of Courts** – Your local prothonotary's office will have its own specific link for scheduling appointments, so use [the search engine](#) to find this information. (This office is usually located in your county courthouse or another satellite office.)
  - **Public Libraries** – Your local library will have its own specific link for scheduling appointments, so use [the search engine](#) to find this information.
  - **Other Local Government Offices**



#### Passport Agency or Center

- [Use this link](#) to locate the nearest passport agency or center near you. You can only make an appointment by calling [1-877-487-2778](tel:1-877-487-2778)

Once you have scheduled your appointment, mark the date and time on your calendar(s). Please arrive before your scheduled appointment time with all of your required documents ready to go. Submit your documents to the officer, and you're all set!
