# STUDY ABROAD IN



Do you want to do more than just scratch the surface of an Irish experience through study abroad? Ireland is a fascinating island, rich in culture, arts and language, full of dramatic landscapes, and famous for its warm, funny, sharp and friendly people. Even going from boom to bust, from a homogenous to a multicultural society and from an inward to an open, modern economy, this country has kept its strong sense of community and its focus on caring for each other as the foundation of its society's well-being.

Arcadia's approach in Ireland uses this sense of community to explore the many facets of life in Ireland today and what it means to be Irish - which you can then use to explore your own identity and direction. Our staff in the Arcadia Dublin Center support all our students on the island, working with you and our partner institutions to ensure you get the most out of your time here academically, personally, socially and culturally - learn outside the classroom in Ireland with the Arcadia community of staff and students.

**Dublin** - The thriving, multicultural capital city is a hub of activity, with half of its population under 30 and students from all over the world. It is brimming with curious things to see and do. It also has easy transport links to the rest of the country and Europe.

**Maynooth** - A friendly college town outside Dublin, Maynooth has a relaxed and welcoming atmosphere, where students integrate easily with locals.

**Cork** - As Ireland's second city, Cork offers an exciting, eclectic arts and music scene that attracts people from all over the world. Nestled on the south coast, the city is surrounded by stunning scenery with many outdoor attractions.

**Galway** - This popular, charming city is bursting with artists, writers, musicians and Irish-speaking storytellers, offering a culturally-rich, unique setting and gorgeous west coast scenery.

**Belfast** - Northern Ireland's largest city embraces a mix of cultural traditions and is accompanied by beautiful landscapes and warm, quick-witted locals.

**Limerick** - Set on the banks of the River Shannon on Ireland's west coast, Limerick is a treasure trove of historical interest and beautiful scenery.

**Ballyvaughan** - This idyllic village on Ireland's west coast sits in the magnificent Burren landscape and offers artistic inspiration, a close-knit community and outdoor exploration.

**Derry/Londonderry** - Located in Northern Ireland, and bordering the Republic of Ireland, Derry/Londonderry is seen as one of the most divided cities on the island. This is due to the many years of difference in politics, religion and historical beliefs.



# **Dublin Parliamentary Internship.**



How about an insider's experience of legislative operations in a small, dynamic assembly? This unique program from Arcadia and the Institute of Public Administration (IPA) offers challenging courses to complement your internship with a Teachta Dála (TD) who is a member of the Irish Parliament, Dáil Eireann. This is an exciting time to study and experience the workings of Irish politics.

- + Only North American students sponsored by the IPA have the privilege to intern in both houses of the Irish Parliament: Dáil Eireann and Seanad Eireann.
- + The IPA is located in an attractive, tree lined area of Dublin and is within easy reach of both the Parliament and the city center.

In addition to your internship, you will take three courses taught at the IPA:

- + Modern Irish Literature: 1890-Present
- + History of Modern Ireland: 1870-Present
- + Irish Society and Politics

- + Duties range from conducting surveys to researching and reporting on issues related to public welfare to preparing press
- + You'll spend two or three full days in your placement and two days each week taking courses with other North American interns in the program.
- + This is a popular program with limited spots, so we encourage you to apply early.

- + This program is open to students at the Junior or Senior level.






# **University College Dublin**

You'll work under the guidance of one of Ireland's leading Engineering schools: the University of Limerick, home to the innovative Bernal Institute, which focuses on the thematic areas such as advanced materials, manufacturing and process engineering and fluid dynamics.

The School of Engineering is research-driven, covering the full spectrum from blue sky fundamentals through to new start-up company research. You will work in state-of-art facilities with researchers who have a strong track record of translating their knowledge and expertise into solutions for both academic and industrial challenges.

- + Identifying security risks that make the modern/electric vehicles susceptible to hacking
- + Computational modeling of mechanical behavior of lightweight carbon fiber materials


