Campus Overview

The Australian Census does not collect information specific to race or ethnicity, rather focusing on ancestry. Generally, the term “student/person of color” is not used in Australia.

As of 2020, The University of Sydney has 35,484 undergraduates.

- 57% are female
- 38% come from a Non-English speaking background
- 30% are international
- 6% indicated having a disability
